BVRC Subscriptions 2016-2017

BVRC club year started on 1st November, so it is time for your annual subscriptions renewal, if you haven't done so already. Rates have remained the same as last year and are £32, for Riding Members, and at £12 for Non Riding Members.

We are offering a discount of £7 to reduce the cost to £25 for riding members, if the subs are paid before 31st December 2016.

BVRC Talk & Demo 'Better with Bowen' Bowen & Thermography on Thursday 24th November, 7.30 for 8pm at The Lion, Clanville, SP11 9HN.

At our first social event this winter qualified Equine & Human Therapists and BVRC members Marion Watt, Fiona Webb and Susie Pool will be explaining what Bowen Therapy and Thermography are and how they might help both horse and rider (and non-riders).

The talk will cover the philosophy of Bowen Therapy, what might be achieved and what is involved in human and animal treatments. Anyone who has any sore, tight backs, necks, knees etc will have the opportunity to take part in a demo treatment to discover how gentle and relaxing it is.

Marion will also explain how Thermography plays its part in identifying where horses are in need of attention and what changes can be seen following treatments. It can also be used on people but they can talk to the therapist anyway!

19. In the event that dissolution of the Club shall occur, the assets of the Club shall be used first to discharge all liabilities of the Club and the remaining assets shall be split equally and given/transferred to the two charities, Wiltshire Air Ambulance and Hampshire and Isle of Wight Air Ambulance.

BRC Area 17 Intermediate Winter Dressage Team Qualifier at Crofton Manor EC, Stubbington, Hants on Saturday 28th

January 2017

The Intermediate Winter Dressage Qualifier and will be held on Saturday 28th January at Crofton Manor EC. The Championships, at Bury Farm, Leighton Buzzard, will be over the same weekend as the Intermediate Indoor Show Jumping (28th, 29th & 30th April 2017).

The competition is for teams of 4 riders, with the best 3 scores to count towards the team total. One or two teams will qualify from each Area but there will not be any individuals to qualify.

Each rider does a different test, either Prelim 7 (2002), Novice 30 (2006), Novice 34 (2009) or Elementary 49 (2009).

BRC Area 17 Novice & Intermediate Winter Show Jumping Qualifier at Moreton EC, Dorset on

Sunday 19th February 2017,

The Intermediate & Novice Show Jumping Team competition will run at Moreton EC in 2017. Both competitions will be outdoors on an all weather surface.

Both teams of four riders compete over two rounds, with jumps for the Novice 80cm (2'6") in the first and 85cm (2'9") in the second round and for the Intermediate jumps at 90cm (3') in the first and 95cm (3'2") The team total is made up from the best three scores in each round.

The winning teams go forward to National Championships, the Novices at Hartpury College EC, Gloucester on 1st / 2nd April and the Intermediate at Bury Farm, Slapton. Bucks on 28th / 29th / 30th April.



BVRC Winter Dressage on Sunday 26th February, 2017 at Castle Farm, Over Wallop

We are returning to Castle Farm for our Winter Dressage. The classes will be run indoors, with warm up outside, on an all weather surface. The schedule will include a Walk & Trot, two Prelims, one Novice & a choice of a Novice, an Elementary or Medium Dressage Tests. There should be something to please everyone.



BVRC Winter Show Jumping on Sunday 19th March, 2017 at Tidworth Equestrian Centre

We are excited to be able to return to Tidworth Equestrian Centre again this year. The all weather arenas provide excellent jumping surfaces both for competition & warm up. Jumping classes will be run at heights from 2' 3" to 3' 3", with clear round jumping at 2'.

Spring Dressage will be held on grass at Redenham Park, tests from Prelim to Medium



BRC Area 17 Combined Training Team & Individual Qualifier at Redenham Park, Nr Weyhill on Sunday 9th April 2017,

The Combined Training qualifier for teams and individuals comprise two levels, one riding BRC HT 90 Q (2013) and showing jumping at 75cm and the second riding BRC HT 100 Q (2013) with a show jumping jump a round at 85cm. Teams comprise four members with two riding at each level.

As always, the best three scores count towards the team total.

Championships will be at Aston le Walls on 20th / 21st May



BRC Area 17 Festival of the Horse Challenge (Combined Show Jumping & Cross Country) Sunday 23rd April 2017,

Rockbourne

A combined show jumping and cross country challenge with classes for Intermediate (height 1m all fences), Novice (height SJ .85m SC .90m) and a new 80cm height this year. This competition is a test of the ability of a pony/horse and rider to negotiate a show jumping course together with a cross country course. The Challenge will involve a round of 7-10 show jumping obstacles and at least 15 (max 28) cross country jumping efforts.

The round will be timed, with the show jumping based on a speed of 325 m/min for all and the cross country 450 m/min for novice and pairs and 475 m/min for intermediate.

Championships will be at Aston le Walls on 20th / 21st May

BVRC Hunter Trials on Sunday 30th October 2016 at PTP Racecourse Larkhill

The postman came to the rescue and brought entries which took us into surplus, just.

Suddenly, everyone discovered that the event was on, and the 'last minute'ers' made a good event into a great one.

Fence judge volunteers were few & far between, even though all 180 members were contacted and asked for help. Heavily reliant on non-members, as always, eventually Ella's pleas were rewarded and a full contingent of fence judges were found.

Little setting up was needed the day before. Two gazebos were erected in record time by experts Sandra & Susie with me watching on. We were ready to go.

Although the start of the Intermediate class was delayed, due to skillful management at the start, proceedings soon caught up and we finished the day on time if not ahead of schedule.

We owe a lot to everyone who helped out on the day and enabled us to run with our normally, legendary efficiency.

So thank you to Susie (secretarial), to Sandra and her super efficient scoring team, to XC start/timing team, to Ella for rounding up & looking after the fence judges & Fi who kept everyone fed & watered, and to everyone who fence judged.
