BVRC President

We are very excited to announce that Lucinda Green has agreed to become BVRC president for the next two years.

Lucinda needs no introduction as an eventing legend.

She is the 1982 World Champion and a two-time European Champion (1975–77). She also won World team Gold (1982), three European team golds (1977, 1985, 1987) and an Olympic silver medal in the team event in 1984. Between 1973 and 1984, she won a record six times at the Badminton Horse Trials (on six different horses). She also won the Burghley Horse Trials in 1977 and 1981.

Now an international XC coach and journalist, Lucinda has said that she would be honoured to become our figurehead President.

We are hopeful that she may be able to fit some of our events into her busy schedule.



BVRC Subscriptions 2017-2018

BVRC club year starts on 1st November, so it is time for your annual subscriptions renewal.

Rates have increased slightly from last year and are £33, for Riding Members, and at £12 for Non Riding Members.

We are offering a discount of £7 to reduce the cost to £26 for riding members, if the subs are paid before 31st December 2017.

We hope that the concession will entice you to renew your subscriptions promptly.

The reduced rate of £26 will apply for second and subsequent members of the same household.

No discount is applicable for non-riding members, as their rate has not increased for many years.

You will need to renew your subscription if you wish to take advantage of the reduced cap when hunting with the RA Hunt.

Subscriptions may be paid by cash or cheque (made payable to Bourne Valley Riding Club) or online.

Online payments are completed through My Riding Life, for which you have to register your own account (free of charge). This will also enable you to enter online many other events in the region which use MRL. There is a single transaction cost of £1.50 when you make a "purchase", to cover the cost of the system provided. It isn't a lot when compared to the cost of the paper, toner, envelope, 65p stamp and time to get to the post box!

BVRC Show Jump Refurbishment

After several years of neglect, BVRC show jumps were beginning to look a bit sorry for themselves. Several of the three part fillers only had two parts intact. Not realising the extent of the task, Pete (Hills) volunteered to do some running repairs – this project was part of his transition to retirement.

Well, what started as a smallish job, developed into full blown reconstruction. Initially, a few fillers needed screwing back together and some lightweight stands stabilised. As more and more fillers fell apart, a major conveyor belt of jump production evolved. As the fillers were completed, attention turned to jump stands & wings. Every available moment was spent painting newly refurbished units – undercoat, first coat, top coat. The poles weren't untouched in this exercise. Several were sanded down – Susie discovered previously unfound sanding skills and new poles purchased to replace rotting ones – more painting. I had a lovely bonfire removing all the old wood!

Relays of painters arrived for the seemingly endless painting. The task was finally concluded at the end of August thanks to the efforts of Lindsay, Susie, Victoria, Ros, Val, Rosie, Fiona, Lynn, Brenda, Mick, Petra and Sandra, whose fortitude and perseverance enabled us to complete the job.

A huge thank you to Pete who must have thought of the 'Forth bridge' when more & more jumps appeared for repair.

We are the proud owners of fifteen jumps, complete with stands, fillers and poles, all beautifully colour coordinated.

We haven't liked to tell Pete we need 2 more sets of jump wings & stands and that the old wall is beyond repair – a nice winter project for him.

Note: It will be a condition of entry in future shows that the owner of any horse found with paint on its hooves will be expected to repair the damage. Brushes & paint will be supplied!

Xmas (Mince Pie) Ride 2017 by Laura Saxon

Having spent a bit of time the previous day persuading Carrot to tolerate tinsel on his bridle, Graham and I assembled on our pretty furry horses (now successfully sporting a small amount tinsel) by the Queen's Building at Larkhill for the annual BVRC mince pie ride. Thirty other horses and riders had come along to join in the fun, variously sporting jingling Santa hats, tinsel, antlers (one horse) and baubles. The cavalry were split in to two groups, the fast and the more sedate, and on account of our horses being a bit woolly and comfortably in to their Christmas holidays a little early, we opted for the slightly slower ride led by Susie Pool and Humphrey. Those people keen to go a bit quicker were led by Helen Nash-Steer, and we all set off under a slightly grey but clear sky, horses feeling fairly jolly and all keen to get going. I think our rides were slightly perplexed as we took them past the cross country course and away in to the distance, but we trotted along a few tracks and everyone began to settle. Usual hacking encounters such as herds of cows, packs of green laning 4x4 drivers, and some scrambler bikes came and went—all the motor sports enthusiasts were very considerate. Slightly less commonplace was the occasional scattering of blank bullet casings under hoof, the odd artillery fuze and the 500lb bomb sticking out of the ground in a cratered field we inadvertently chose for a quick canter! That aside, one advantage of riding on MOD land is the distribution of portaloos. Most of the way around our lovely circular route we came across one slightly wobbly aforementioned convenience which a few riders took advantage of! There are some really beautiful views to be had on Salisbury Plain and the gentle undulation of the ground and warming sun gave us some wonderful views of the mixed deciduous and evergreen forests and copses that just previously we have been riding through. Coming literally full-circle we finished our ride past the old cross country course, and were treated to the sight of a very handsome buzzard surveying us from his vantage point. The quicker ride made it back a little ahead of us, so we all untacked fairly rapidly and hot footed it over to the fantastic spread of mulled wine, mince pies and frankly brilliant sausage rolls made by Caroline Thompson and set up by Celia. As with all BVRC social events the 2106 mince pie ride was a great opportunity to see old friends, meet new ones and generally have a good natter with everyone. BVRC – ‘All about Trec’ talk on 19th April at Weyhill Fair - ever wondered what TREC is all about?

Julia Knight-Jones' informative talk gave an insight into what it is really about.

Originating in France, TREC tests the bond between horse and rider over three 'disciplines'. It is designed to give the trekking horses and riders something to showcase their skills. It consists of map reading while riding at set speeds over different terrain, testing the rider's control of the canter then the walk, and the final phase is an obstacle course simulating natural challenges.

If any of these statements ring true for you, look no further....TREC is the answer for you.

Following on from the successful talk by Julia Knight-Jones, we held TREC training sessions.

It gave a taste of TREC, participants tried some of the obstacles that might be faced in a competition and the chance to test speeds at walk and canter. Most of all it was FUN.

Our first competition of 2017 took place at Castle Farm on 26th February. This dressage competition has usually run with around 50 tests in recent years. This year we had 76 entries, many arriving at the eleventh hour, and ran with just over 70 on the day. It was an early start and long day for the Organiser & Secretary with extra helpers arriving throughout the day. Initial concerns about space in the lorry park proved unfounded. The biggest no-show, unfortunately, was the caterer, due to illness, but a dash to the shops for refreshments and sandwiches plugged the gap, with thanks to Vanessa Vernon for use of her mugs and kettle.
