A ride across fields, tracks and byways with glorious views across rolling farmland and the Salisbury basin. The ride will take in field edges, tracks, hills, farmyards, wooded sunken lanes and spinneys, chalk byways, stubble fields, some gates and other country hazards – expect the unexpected!

There will be two rides led by livery residents Vicki de Candole and Lindsay Devine, one slightly longer than the other to allow for pace and fitness. We'll stop at the welcoming The Kings Head Pub, Redlynch for a pre-paid roll (tuna/ham/cheese) and soft drink (lime&soda/orange squash etc) about half way round but feel free to bring your own pennies if you'd like other/more than that. There'll be recovery squash and cake on our return. Charge for lunch/refreshments will be £3.50 per person.
