#### **BRC Insurance**

As a Riding Club affiliated to the British Horse Society, BVRC carries a certain level of insurance cover. It has become apparent that clarification is needed about the insurance cover of individual club members. The policy offers third party personal liability insurance. Members will be insured whilst taking part in activities (riding or helping) organised by BVRC, another BHS affiliated Riding Club or British Riding Clubs office at Stoneleigh. Travel to and from activities is **EXCLUDED**. Members are **NOT INSURED** outside RC activities, e.g. hacking out independently. #### **British Riding Clubs Rule Book**

British Riding Clubs' Competitions Official Rules book is now available to view online on the BHS / Riding Clubs website. All BVRC competitions are run under BRC Rules. Members who compete may wish to familiarise themselves with rules /eligibility and with dress / tack rules.

If you want further information on Riding Club competitions rules etc. please visit the British Riding Clubs website which has a wealth of information for members www.bhs.org.uk/riding/british\_riding\_clubs.aspx.

Unlike in previous years, the 2011 Rule Book came into effect on 1st January.

#### **Riding Hats**

Anyone riding at our events MUST wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard (EN1384), with a harness properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

Hard hats to specification PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163 and BSEN14572:2005 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384. Recommended hard hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark, SEI. or QAS. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95 and Australian/New Zealand standard SNZ3838 1998 are also acceptable. Skullcaps must be worn with a silk.

#### A HAT WITH A FIXED PEAK IS NOT PERMISSIBLE FOR CROSS COUNTRY.

Please be aware before you turn up that you bring the right hat with you to every single riding event & competition that we run.

It has come to light that Patey are making a riding hat with a harness. Please note that this hat does not conform to BRC & BVRC requirements and is not allowed in BRC or BVRC competitions. This link \_http://www.pateyhats.com/harness-option/\_ (http://www.pateyhats.com/harness-option/) shows that the hat could well be mistaken for an approved riding hat, so please be aware.

# BRC Area 17 Novice Indoor Show Jumping Qualifier at Crofton EC, Stubbington, Hants on Saturday 5 March 2011,

Teams of four riders compete over two rounds, with jumps 80cm (2'6") in the first and 85cm (2'9") in the second round. The team total is made up from the best three scores in each round. The winning teams go forward to National Championships at Hartpury College EC on  $2^{nd}$  /  $3^{rd}$  April.

Horses with any BSJA winnings, BE points or BE Pre-Novice  $1^{st} - 6^{th}$  places are ineligible.

PLEASE CONTACT SUSIE IMMEDIATELY if you would like to be considered for a team place. Tel: 01980 671523 or email: <a href="mailto:susie pool@tiscali.co.uk">susie pool@tiscali.co.uk</a> Then fill in and return the team application form (enclosed with the newsletter) with copies of the horse's Flu Vacc Certificate / Passport. To be sure of being considered for a place, the form needs to be submitted to Susie by Monday 7th February 2011. You've got to be in it to win it!

#### **Team Information**

Please remember that your horse needs to have a fully up to date flu certificate/passport, and you will need to have paid your subscriptions.

There are some restrictions in the eligibility of horses and riders for the various competitions. If you wish to be considered for a place in any of the competitions, please fill in and return the attached team forms to Susie Pool, together with two photocopies of the horse's Passport / Flu vacc certificate (one copy for the competition for which you would like to be considered + one extra for Susie). Please make sure you copy every section (front, back & middle) of the certificate — including the name & address of the owner, the horse's name, silhouette, markings & every single vaccinations entry.

The team application forms give details of the latest date for them to be returned.

## ONCE YOU HAVE RETURNED YOUR FORM PLEASE LET SUSIE KNOW IMMEDIATELY IF YOU ARE NO LONGER AVAILABLE. The team competitions cost the club a lot of money, which we do not want to waste.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response to the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter. Details of how many teams and individuals we want to enter are sent, **with an entry fee,** to British Riding Clubs (3-4 weeks before the competition). Anyone applying for team places will be notified if their application has been successful.

Entries detailing who is in which team is sent to the Area Competition Organiser (with another entry fee) about 7-10 days before the competition is held.

We are asking team members to make a contribution to entry fees to area qualifying competitions. We are requesting £15 for each team / individual place, to be enclosed with the application form. A refund will only be made in the event of injury / illness to horse or rider which prevents them from participating in the competition.

The club pays all entry fees to Championships.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered the opportunity to ride for the club.

The area competitions are great events giving us the opportunity to meet and compete against other clubs in the area and participate in a team environment. We want to encourage any one interested to have a go, but in the event of teams qualifying for National Championships, we need to know in advance if you are prepared to go the Championships.

There may be many reasons why you can't or don't want to attend the Championships. It will not stop us asking you to represent the club, but it may just affect who goes in which team.

If you think you would like to have a go but are not sure then ring Susie (01980 671523) for a chat.

Even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return the team application forms.

# PLEASE READ THE FLU VACC RULES SHOWN BELOW AND MAKE SURE YOUR HORSE'S Certificate COMPLIES WITH THE RULES IN EVERY RESPECT.

BRC equine influenza rules are based on the British Horseracing Authority Rules (BHA formerly The Jockey Club Rules).

Susie will check all certificates submitted to her but please remember that it is your responsibility to ensure your horse has a valid certificate that fully complies with the BHA Rules in all respects.

The certificate will have to be presented at all BRC Official Competitions.

#### <u>Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates - Vaccination procedures</u>

Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, <u>signed and stamped</u> on each relevant line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal.

It must state that the horse has received the appropriate course of injections against Equine Influenza as follows:

Two injections, the 2<sup>nd</sup> between 21 days and 92 days after the 1<sup>st</sup>. **Primary Vaccination:** 

First Booster: An injection between 150 days and 215 days after 2<sup>nd</sup> primary injection.

An injection not more than 1 year after the preceding injection. Annual Booster

Only the first two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete.

None of the vaccinations may be given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.

Annual Boosters may be given on the same date each year, but this is not recommended.

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.

Note: Where Passports are used as the flu' vaccination record, the horse description must be verified by a vet or authorised member of a breed society.

If the passport does not contain the full vaccination history then, to comply with rule above, the flu vaccination certificate must also accompany the pony/horse to all BRC Qualifiers and Championships.

#### Checking of certificates at BRC competitions is very stringent and the BRC Rulebook says the following:

Full vaccination histories and drawings will be checked at all Area Qualifiers and at all Championships before the pony or horse is allowed to compete, and anyone with an invalid certificate will not be permitted to compete. Any pony/horse that is in a team competition that is disqualified at an Area Qualifier cannot be replaced, the team will have to continue as a team of three, or if already a team of three, will have to compete as individuals only, if there is an individual competition.

Any pony/horse disqualified at an Area Qualifier under this rule will be reported to the BRC Office. If that team qualifies for a Championship then the disqualified pony/horse cannot be replaced with a reserve for that Championship and the team must remain a team of three.

#### It is worth remembering

There is now a legal requirement for a valid passport to accompany the horse when traveling to any competition.

All horse must have a current flu vaccination certificate.

#### PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES ABOVE AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

The facilities at Stockland Lovell include

an extensive cross country course with in excess of 100 fences from 1'6" to 3'9", two all weather arenas (one for flatwork and one with show jumps), marked routes for hacking around the farm saddlery shop.

The plan is to have six riding sessions, Monday afternoon, 2 each on Tuesday and Wednesday and one on Thursday morning. Please indicate on the booking form the type (hacking, flatwork, gridwork, show jumping or cross country) and how many sessions of riding you would like to do (not more than 2 of each jumping type, maximum of 6 sessions). We can't promise, but we will do our best to satisfy your choice.

Our allocation is for 40-45 people / horses. The cost will be £235 of which a £85 deposit shall be paid on return of the attached application form (no later than  $25^{th}$  February) and the remainder will be payable on or before  $18^{th}$  March. Shavings supplied by SL will cost £7.50 per bale (4 bales are usually adequate but more may be purchased if needed). A second horse may be brought, if space permits, at a cost of £60.
