TACK THEFTS

As you are probably aware there has been a rapid increase in tack thefts in this area. I have been contacted by the Wiltshire Constabulary who are going to collate all information regarding this matter.

The Officer responsible for receiving this information is PC 694 Gabriel Tilsed, who can be contacted at Salisbury Police Station, tel: 0722 41144 extension 3184.

Police enquiries have shown that premises with horses have had visits from members of the public making, quite often legitimately, enquiries regarding costs of livery, lessons etc., for themselves or maybe for someone else.

Usually there will be a guided tour of the yard including the tack room. Then the less honest will return, sometimes many weeks later, at night and steal tack.

So please report any such occurrences, with car registration number if possible. This will help the police to identify the offenders.
