Practice Dressage and Show Jumping at Amport Riding School, Thursday 1st June, 6pm.

As usual, as the events get heavier, we try to put on some specific practice sessions in dressage and show jumping. This time it has been organised ready for the Larkhill combined training. The general idea is to have a practise under the eagle eye of a dressage judge or show jumping instructor, then discuss any problems and have another go. The evening has proved exceptionally popular over the past couple of years. It is a brilliant place to bring a youngster for a first time out, to have a go at a dressage test or show jumping round for the first time (or both) or just to try a new horse. Dressage tests will cover Prelim 6, 14 & Novice 27. Show Jumping will be based on the height that your comfortable with. If you feel unsure then just give Lindsay a bell, but if you fancy a go then fill in the reply slip and send it to Lindsay. The cost is £7 for the dressage or show jumping or £12 for both

The tuition will be held at Manor Farm, Fullerton.

BVRC Bloomers – Have you enjoyed ‘Auntie’s Bloomers’ on TV? Here are a few BVRC Bloomers that might amuse you, and make you feel better if you’ve ever been guilty of not engaging brain before entering the arena!

Long ago Bourne Valley entered a team in the Area One Day Event to be held on the County Show Ground at Shepton Mallet.

These early events phased Dressage, Cross Country and Show Jumping in that order.

Two of our team were very experienced from a well known riding school. Three of our team had finished (two with good scores, and one eliminated). Our last rider had a clear round Show Jumping and we might have been amongst the rosettes – we were all on tenterhooks.

The team manager was heard to remark “Where’s W-----? She’s next on, has she walked the course?”, Dave Packman said “Don’t worry, that girl knows the ropes. Here she comes, good luck, good luck.”

She cantered in, we held our breathe – the starting bell rang – she galloped straight through the Finish Posts in the wrong direction and over the LAST FENCE also in the wrong direction!!!! She cleared it, but the judges’ bell rang – Disqualified.

National Show Jumping at Stoneleigh – We had a strong team and had three riders clear in the first round. In the second round we still had two members clear.

Col Bob was in the ring. We watched with baited breath as he tackled the ten fences. “He’s clear – he’s clear” we told each other. The tannoy crackled across the arena – “Would the last competitor please come to the judges please.”

What on earth was happening? Again the tannoy crackled – “The last competitor has been eliminated.”

“What happened, what happened? Where did you go wrong?”

“I didn’t.” said Col Bob “I was disqualified, they said my whip was too long. Look here it is. I lost the leather bit on the end, so I tied on that wiggly bit of binder twine.”

When they straightened out the wiggle, it was two inches over the limit – disqualified!

At Stoneleigh again – Various team members wending their way North on a Sunday morning, one young competitor being driven by her father, a vicar, who was taking a day off work.

They had a problem with their trailer ten miles short of Stoneleigh when passing through a small town. Closer investigation revealed that a damaged wheel bearing had disintegrated, and the balls had dropped down a drain!

A following competitor pulled up behind them and suggested that the problem was retribution for father missing work. The horse was safely transported on to the show, and a garage sought to repair the trailer. With repairs completed and a warning to get attention for the remaining wheel bearing, the family duly set off, with the horse, for a weeks holiday in North Wales.

Returning home very late on the following Sunday evening, as they drew into the yard, the second wheel bearing went. Luckily they were all home safe and sound - so maybe someone was looking after them after all.
