Sylvia Hart's Highland Fling, now 17 years, was the first Bourne Valley horse to go in the championships 9 years ago, ridden in the dressage competition by Lindsay, and Sue Hollands had him going as well as ever.

Congratulations also to Mork Antrobus and Geoffry Fairfoull, riding Mr Spock and Folly's Fancy who gained top marks for the team in the Prix Caprilli. Anna Willis unfortunately had to withdraw from this competition due to a nasty fall the day previously, (now happily recovered) and her place was nobly taken by Mary Creese riding Rob, who also gave Norman Creese a satisfactory clear in the final round of the show jumping. Sandra Oliver and evergreen Bob Huskinson were the backbone of the show jumping team, with Tom Oliver riding another evergreen, Satan, in the Equitation jumping. Newcomers, Joe King and Ann McKellar also acquitted themselves well and Sue Bennett must have been delighted with her young horse's performance in the Team dressage.

Our main Autumn events are the club gymkana at Kinpton, and the One Day Event at Amport. If these two events are as successful as the Combined Training organised by Sue Bennett and Shirley Myall at Penton, they will be well worth supporting. Helpers are urgently required at both events.
