NEWSLETTER February 1999

As always nothing is straightforward or easy. Having forged ahead with provisional competition dates, and got approval for dates and competitions at Larkhill, the problems struck. Hoplands EC, our normal venue for winter Dressage and Show Jumping, is unavailable at present, although we are hopeful that we may return there next year. The hunt was then on to find alternative venues for these competitions.

Sorrel very kindly sought permission for our Dressage to be held at Cholderton House EC. With fewer facilities available than at Hoplands we will be restricted to using one rather than two arenas for competition, but there will be plenty of warming up space. We are still trying to sort out the Show Jumping competition.

Our original One Day Event date on 6th June clashed with the date arranged for the Area 17 inter club Show Jumping Qualifier. After many phone calls we have managed to re arrange our One Day Event to 13th June.

Please mark all the important dates in your diaries, but do keep an eye on the Diary Dates page in case events get shuffled again.

Rule Reminder

The club doesn't have too many rules, but just as a general reminder to keep everyone on the straight and narrow. Here are details of the ones that seem to cause most problems.

BVRC membership is open to people 17 years old or older (with no upper age limit). 16 year olds may compete in competitions and attend any riding event as a member's guest, (with permission of the organiser) but BVRC does not allow under 16's to ride at their events. They do however, welcome guests of any age at their socials.

Anyone riding at our events MUST wear correct approved headgear. The current standard is **at least to the recommended standards PAS015 or EN1384**; **hats prefixed SEI/ASTM are permissible** (ASTM is not valid on its own, it must have **the SEI prefix**). Hats shall have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted. Bit unflattering perhaps, but we are not insured if we allow people to ride in incorrect headgear, so please be aware before you turn up and bring the right hat with you.

Body protectors shall be worn for any event involving cross country jumping.

Otherwise there is no particular dress code, it is sufficient just to be "clean and tidy". Correct footwear (i.e. no muckers) is a good idea. Jewellery lovers please note it is not permissible to wear earings whilst competing. Not even studs. This is for safety reasons not just appearance.

Full details of the rules are shown in the club's constitution (sounds dreadfully painful doesn't it). Copies can be obtained from Lindsay 01264 772388.

Be Fair Cup and Caballine Trophy

The Be Fair Cup and Caballine Trophy are awarded annually. The Be Fair points are awarded to the 6 highest placed BV members in every competition regardless of their overall places (they may be 10^{th} in the class but 2^{nd} best BV member). Riders are only eligible for points on one horse on any particular day.

Members who compete in teams on behalf of the Bourne Valley will receive five points per day.

The Caballine Trophy points are awarded on a point for each hour or part hour worked at a show or setting up the day before a show. Committee members who organise the events only get points for the day before and the actual day of the competition, even so the top places do seem to be filled by them. A rose bowl is awarded to the highest placed non-committee member.

Rosettes are awarded to the top ten places in each competition at the AGM at the end of the year. Each Trophy winner is awarded free membership for the following year.

Two new sections have been added to the Caballine Trophy

We are introducing a Partners competition. Each member may nominate a non-member partner, the helpers point for the pair are accumulated throughout the year. The pair who accrue the most points will receive rosettes, free membership for the member and a prize for the non-member.

Points for helping will also be kept for non Members with a rosette & prize awarded at the end of the year.

Memories (by Sam Hart)

The Bourne Valley Riding Club was founded over 30 years ago. I wasn't amongst the first members (who wants to ride round in circles in a small paddock when you have all of Salisbury Plain to ride over?), but my family joined and I soon followed suit.

June Bush was a founder member who over the years has served as Secretary – President – Scorer and has handed me the original news letters.

It's been great fun to identify the early members who figured in committees or competitions and are still with us. Roy Southey, Richard Hale, Sylvia and Lindsay Hart, Sue Bennet, Col B Huskisson, Jill Vallis, Mrs Skelton, Elizabeth Derbyshire and I expect there will be a few more when I travel through the next lot of newsletters.

In 1967 the British Horse Society was promoting the formation of Riding Clubs on a regional basis and we joined Area 17 (Hampshire – Dorset – Isle of Wight).

What were Riding Clubs for? To promote good horsemanship? We organised fun rides from each other's neck of the woods – Hurstbourne – Penton – Shipton – Weyhill, but later started focussing more on improving our riding by taking Riding Club Tests I, II, and III. But it was 3 or 4 years before any of us got Grade III. Our first competitions were "Prix Caprilli" a simple dressage test with two small jumps in the arena and judged not on the horses paces, but the riders ability. It was a pity when it was abandoned.

We were of course lucky. We were able to use the Tidworth Indoor School, the Polo Grounds, Mrs Skeltons' Harroway establishment and Dave Packman's place at Lock's Drive.

Dave Packman was an enthusiastic member, and the leader of our social activities. He organised annual dinners at Bere House Hotel and Rothsey, with prominent guest speakers. We had guest speakers and forums at Tedworth House and "Yes" swimming sessions at Lady Dockers' indoor heated pool near Stockbridge!!! Sylvia Hart hosted several annual Harvest Moon bonfires in September, when we barbecued and sang the hits of the 'Sixties' with the help of several guitars.

By 1969 our equestrian ability was such, as not only did our Show Jumping team qualify for Hickstead National Riding Club competition, but our current Chairperson Lindsay qualified for the National Dressage Championships at Stoneleigh. Later we entered our first Area One Day Event at Alderholt and came fourth!

There were Hunter Trials at Harroway and Locks Drove, more instruction on the flat and in 1973 we were the first club to qualify for the National Championship in all four disciplines, Prix Caprilli – Dressage – Show Jumping and One Day Event. For the first time we felt confident enough to organise the Area One Day Event, and several Area Show Jumping – Dressage – Prix Caprilli qualifiers at Tidworth.

For fun we had Show Jumping competitions at Tidworth Indoor School, against both the Royal Artillary and the Tedworth Pony Club (riders had to grab a sugar mouse hanging on a Christmas Tree acting as a wing).

There was a lot of support for visits to local studs and club members were up to 74 – we were well established.

I must read the next lot of files, so more many happy memories.....
