#### **AGM Report**

At our recent Annual General Meeting, marking the end of the club's 32<sup>nd</sup> year, chairperson Lindsay Hills told members that the club now had a record 200 members. 30 members in 12 teams represented the club in Area Competitions.

There has been a lot of hard work completed by the committee helped by many non-members.

During the year we have had training sessions in all disciplines, dressage, show jumping and combined training competitions, a hunter trial and we also hosted the Area 17 One Day Event for Riding Clubs in Hampshire, Dorset and the Isle of Wight.

Treasurer Brenda Harman reported that the club was in a good financial position and it would not be necessary to raise subscriptions for 1999.

In the absence of any other nominations Lindsay Hills was elected to the chair, and Brenda Harman elected as treasurer for another two year term. Secretary Sarah March still has to serve another year and did not need to be re-elected. The Chairman thanked all the hard working committee members especially mentioning those who were retiring after a lengthy period of office. In National Competitions, Area 17 representatives figured very strongly with team & individual winners and places in all disciplines. BVRC made their own contribution with Serena Potter and Folkin Philomel placed second in the National Novice Horse Trials Championships and Lucinda Burtenshaw and Silver Clay winning the Medium Dressage Championships. Lucinda brought the magnificent Medium Dressage Trophy, won for the second year in succession by a BVRC member, and winners sash to the AGM for us all to admire. For many it will be the closest we will ever get to a National Trophy. The Caballine trophy for the best helper of the year was won by Clare Heald. The Rose bowl for the highest placed non committee helper was awarded to Caroline Stevens.
