Brenda Harmon won the Top Score Competition for Help The Aged and so goes on to the Bath & West Summer Show in July for the Regional Final. If she gains success there, her next stop will be Olympia at Christmas! A sum of £54 was sent to Help The Aged, plus all sponsorship money from individual riders. Well done to those who collected so much - Brenda, Sandra, Elaine Elderton, Melissa McKee and Jo King to name a few. The rest of the proceeds from the day's jumping (£88) went to the Leukaemia Care Society.
