The area show jumping team competitions were held at Stocklands on Sunday, 9th June. Some 18 clubs in our area were eligible to enter a team but only 6 did due to the very high standard - (3' 9" at area level, up to 4' 3" at the championship). Our show jumping team consisted of two new members - Sarah Oldham riding "I Presume" and Caroline Berry riding "Juniper Ega Be", and two old stagers!! - Gill Trickett riding "Pembrena Matty" and Sandra Olliver riding Flippant Fancy. Sarah had the problem of being first to go in each of two rounds. Gill Trickett rode her first round in a cloud burst but was one of only two competitors to do a double clear round. Bourne Valley did extremely well and we are pleased to report that they were the competition winners. The team now go to the National Championships at Stoneleigh on 17th August 1985.

THE BE FAIR CHALLENGE CUP

Donated By Mrs. Lucinda Green In 1985

The Committee have agreed that the winner will also receive one year's free membership of the Bourne Valley Riding Club.

The Rules are as follows:

1. The Be Fair Cup will remain the property of the Bourne Valley Riding Club at all times and is held in trust for one year only by the successful member.
  2. The Cup cannot be awarded to the same member two years in succession.
  3. The Cup will be awarded annually at the Annual General Meeting each October.
  4. Only fully paid members of the Bourne Valley Riding Club, at the time of the competition, may qualify.
  5. Only classes held by the Bourne Valley Riding Club will qualify for the Cup.
  6. Points will be awarded as follows:  
1st = 9 points, 2nd = 6 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, 6th = 1 point.  
Each class, irrespective of the number of Bourne Valley entries in that class, will count for the above points.  
5 points will be awarded to any member who helps at a competition but does not compete.
  7. Members have the right to enter as many horses as they wish but only the highest placed horse in each class will count for points.
  8. In the event of a tie at the end of the year, the winner will be decided on positions in each class.
  9. The Club reserves the right to withhold points or to disqualify any rider found to be in breach of the rules in any class held by the Bourne Valley Riding Club.
  10. The Honorary Treasurer will be responsible for the running of the competition throughout the year and the Honorary Treasurer's decision is final.
  11. Bourne Valley Riding Club members have the right to amend these rules at the Annual General Meeting if they so desire.
