One Day Event at Larkhill on 8th June, 1997

After a years absence, BVRC had a very successful return to Larkhill for our One Day Event. The competition attracted 200 competitors from near and far. A large contingent travelled from the IOW, others from Oxford, Wantage, Frome, Shaftesbury, Blandford, Lymington, Bournemouth, Petersfield & Arundel. Such was the number of competitors that Class 1 was divided into 3 sections & the 100 in class 2 were divided into 4 sections, whilst 30 contested the Open Class.

Torrential rain in the 3 days prior to the competition softened the concrete ground to give near perfect conditions in all 3 phases. The day suffered 3 or 4 torrential downpours with wind & driving rain but luckily this didn't last too long (long enough for those caught in it!!). The Show Jumping caused quite a few problems in the early classes but rode very well later in the day. The refurbished Cross Country course rode as well as ever.

An accident outside the show jumping ring resulted in new member, Gary Caddy dislocating his shoulder when his horse slipped up. We hope that he makes a speedy recovery.

The day was overshadowed by the loss of Blackthorne, Gail Perren's horse, who died of a heart attack whilst on the cross country course. Our sympathies are with Gail and her family.

Stable Management

A few more attended the hands on foot/shoeing talk by Chris Linssner and found this very enlightening & entertaining. Hopefully Chris can be persuaded to do another talk in the autumn.

Area 17 Novice and Open Horse Trials Team Qualifying Competitions at Brockwood Park on 15th June.

After an easy ride with team selections for the Novice indoor Show Jumping Team, the usual selection problems returned with a vengeance. Four team members and one replacement fell by the wayside within a week of the event, so it was fairly miraculous to arrive with two Novice teams and an Open team, albeit with only three members.

The course at Brockwood Park is set in beautiful undulating parkland. The dressage arenas were a little cramped, and had the disadvantage of overlooking the cross country course. The show jumping and cross country course were well constructed. The sheep had closely cropped the grass making the twisty cross country course slippery, which meant it was difficult to maintain any rhythm or speed. The cross country course was dominated by three fences, a trakhener, a water complex and a quarry early on the course. The first two provided very little difficulties, but many fell foul of the latter. One Novice team finished seventh of fifteen teams, with Rachel Fraser individual fifth in her section. The Open team finished fifth out of six teams.
