Dressage Competition at West Woodhay (Nr Newbury) on Sunday 2nd July. (schedule enclosed)

Our Annual Dressage Show returns to West Woodhay again this year. This is the most lovely venue in parkland. The going was perfect last year even though all surrounding areas were baked hard. You may have never heard of West Woodhay, but it really isn't very far away & it is well worth the trip. There are detailed directions in the schedule, which is enclosed with this Newsletter. There are additional directions for those coming from Andover who wish to avoid the steep hill and narrow road just before West Woodhay village. With seven classes, and the first class with a section for those not having been placed in a dressage class, there should be something for everyone. Please get your entries in promptly.

An Afternoon with Gary Witheford at WestCourt Stables, Westcourt, Burbage on Saturday 8th July at 2pm.

At Gary's establishment, the term, 'Natural Horsemanship', is used. They believe it is possible for the horse's owner to develop an understanding of the horse's behaviour and, using 'Call-Up' method, establish a unique bond with their own horse.

Establishing call-up (the bonding of the horse to a leader) is the ultimate aim of natural horsemanship. Once this is achieved, then further work can be completed on the basis that if the owner has no problem with whatever hazard is encountered in the stable or out on a ride, then the horse shouldn't have either. With a leader to follow, imitating the instinct of a herd-living animal, the horse actively seeks to work with its trainer/owner rather than trying to resist.

We have arranged a visit to Gary Witheford's yard in Burbage to watch Gary working with his horses. This is not a formal demonstration, but a chance to observe Gary, under normal conditions, dealing with problem horses.

Cost is £6 members, £7 non-members to include light refreshment. No dreaded reply slips this time, but please ring Lindsay (01264 772388) to let us know who to expect on the afternoon.

Clear Round Jumping at Blackburn Farm, Grateley on Wednesday 12th July 6pm

As we will be setting our jumps for the Show Jumping on 16th July, we decided that we would run a Clear Round Jumping Evening. Height to suit but please try to come early if you want low jumps and slightly later for larger fences.

Cost £2.50 per round, £6 for three rounds. (pay as you go).

One Day Event at Larkhill on 21st May

This year our One Day Event was run two weeks earlier than normal at the request of the XC course builder. Entries were down by 30-50 on last year. Whether this was because we moved the date forward we shall never know. I thought something strange was happening when the postman wasn't staggering up our drive with sacks full of entries and the phone was much quieter than ever before. Nevertheless, there were still around 160 entries, plenty enough to make it a good day.

There were the usual organisational hiccups. We couldn't park lorries in the normal place because the ground was being prepared for a harrier jump jet to land (not on the 21st thankfully). The designated approach road to the parking area was being refurbished, leaving a very muddy, rutted, slippery alternative. The organisation supplying XC Score collectors couldn't be contacted to confirm the booking until 3 days before the event. The pole trailer had a tyre blow out on the A303 on the way to Larkhill, and another towing vehicle had a complete hydraulic fluid failure. At 12:58pm on Saturday the XC course was not ready for the 1pm inspection. Fence 10 in the Open was sitting between fences 3 & 4. Jump numbers 11-15 in the Novice were on fences 12-16, and no marking flags were in position. The cavalry arrived and rapidly put things to rights. Apart from all this, the preparation ran smoothly.

The split of competitors between the classes meant we could run more efficiently if the Class 2 Intermediates ran before the Class 1 Novices. This worked well from a number of points of view. Not many grumbles came from the Intermediates about their early start, and many thanks came from the Novices who were given an unusual lay in.

The day itself ran like clockwork. Although, punctuated with sharp downpours, we were very lucky with the weather considering the torrential rain in the week that followed.

Entries from club members were good, with one section in Class 2 filled exclusively with members. This was a hotly contested section, with last year's David Packman trophy winner, Carolyn Carter being narrowly beaten by her friend and rival Jane Mann, only XC time penalties dividing them. Carolyn's horse, Pip, originally came from the Mann's yard. Diana Burgess and Jane Mann filled the next three places, and Angus, Jane's husband was also in the ribbons. Class 1 was won by Carole Perren & Charlie, and they took home the trophy that Gail Perren had returned that morning. The magnificent "Doorsteps" trophy for the best BV member in the Open Class was taken home by local vet, Jill Richardson. The Open Class was won by well known event rider, Robert Lemieux. It should be a lesson to us all, that on his second horse, Robert was eliminated in the Dressage because the horse was wearing boots. Even the "experts" make mistakes!

A faller near end of the Open disappeared completely from view into the ditch before the large hedge. When she reappeared, it transpired that she had broken her collar bone - this was the fourth time - twice on each side, and the seventh bone she had broken and she was only seventeen years old. Aside from this accident, we had a very incident free day. Our new refreshment service, supplied by Jill Vallis, kept fence judges, stewards, scorers, helpers of all descriptions, and sometimes even bystanders, well plied with food and drink. This was well received by all.

Many thanks to everyone who helped out on the day and to set up on the preceding two days - we couldn't have done it without you.
