Its a quickie no come on get a grip, a little newsletter I meant. We need helpers!!!!! Dressage event, One Day Event, Combined Training. We're doing them all. We need a intzy wintzy bit of help, just to push it along a bit. You know, like forty fence judges, twelve dressage writers, six stewards, and just a few show jump movers, dressage & show jumping ring putter uppers. Now then, how many people did I say we had in the club now. I know you're out there. You can't just impersonate gophers, we Need You.

Right then, what does it mean, well, fence judges get fed and watered and watch people jump over fences. If you haven't done it before, you get put with someone who has. If you can't do all day, then we only need you for just a morning or just an afternoon. Maureen Burford and Sue Kerrison have sent out loads of letters asking people to help with this, so if you feel you can, please send them back asap so we know how many jumps we can use for the course. Now, dressage writers, you guys get to learn what the judge is looking for when you ride a test. Its quite nifty to find out just whereabouts on a dressage arena the judge can't see what your doing. If you haven't done it before, then no matter, there is a first time for everything, and, I can from personal experience say, that it is a lot less nerve wracking than riding the test. Now stewards, they get to meet everybody. Again, your only needed for a few hours at a time, say three or four max, and you make sure that people have arrived, that their numbers on the right way up, and then just point them in the right direction to start. Good one to tire out the kids and the dogs. For the PA's of the relationships, we have the heavy work, hammering in fence posts, moving jump poles, racing round on quad bikes (who said that?), come on chaps, spare us a couple of hours on one of the competition days or the day before for setting up, either the 8th June ring Lindsay Hills 01264 772388 or Monica Tomkins 01264 366407 or 22nd June ring Maggie Miller 01264 781633.

Practise Dressage and Show Jumping at Amport Riding School, 28th May and 4th June, 6pm.

Don't forget about these. This time they're being placed ready for the Larkhill one day event and the combined training. The general idea is to have a practise under the eagle eye of a dressage judge or show jumping instructor, then discuss any problems and have another go. Its proved exceptionally popular over the past couple of years, and despite being placed in front of two of our major events, is actually a brilliant place to bring a youngster for a first time out, to have a go at a dressage test or show jumping round for the first time (or both) or just to try a new horse. Dressage tests will cover Prelim 10, Horse Trials Tests B and D and Novice 27, or any other by arrangement. Show Jumping will be based on the height that your comfortable with. If you feel unsure then just give Lindsay a bell, but if you fancy a go then fill in the reply slip and send it to Lindsay asap. The cost is £4.00 for the dressage or show jumping or £7.00 for both.
