NEWSLETTER

NOVEMBER 2000

Due to pressure of work it has been necessary to postpone the AGM from the Tuesday 14th November to Tuesday 21st November. I apologise if this has caused any inconvenience. Further AGM details are given below.

The autumn season has been as action packed as the summer. Our successful September Show was followed in October with the Area 17 Novice and Open Team and Individual Hunter Trial Qualifiers held on two consecutive weekends. The Championships associated with the Qualifiers are scheduled for 13th May 2001. This seemed a bit far ahead to get to excited about especially with the prospect of Winter between now and then. This was the first time a Qualifier has been run for 3 or 4 years and certainly the first time we have officially entered teams.

Contrary to the fears of some members, although we were hosting the Open HT Qualifier with our own Hunter Trial at Larkhill, the emphasis was always on own HT with the Qualifier slotting in with this. I anticipated that there would not be many takers for the Qualifier, so the only effect to us was running the classes in a different order. This would give the Novices a chance of a lie in, whilst the Open competitors a chance to ride in daylight, not in the gathering gloom.

Ride at Firgo Farm, Whitchurch on Sunday 26th November, 2000 meet at 10am.

Being a former UK Chasers course, there are lots of jumps of varying heights, none of which you have to jump if you don't want to. It does however, give you a chance to go round a course in a group. The ride is open to members and non-members (over 16 years of age).

Directions:- Firgo Farm is situated on the A34 about 1 mile North (towards Newbury) of the A34/A303 junction at Bullington Cross. The signs for the farm aren't very big so please drive slowly so that you don't miss the turning.

Pre Christmas Ride on Salisbury Plain, from the Bustard Hotel, Sunday 10th December, 2000 meet at 10am.

This will be a bracing 10-12 mile ride across Salisbury Plain. If there are sufficient numbers the ride will be split into groups according to ability/experience/fitness. Area 17 Novice Team and Individual Hunter Trial Qualifier at Dene Farm on Sunday 22nd October.

Two teams were entered at the preliminary stage of this competition but as normally happens, people or horses fell by the wayside before the actual day. Arriving on the morning of the competition we were in the position of having two teams of three. With some quick thinking we substituted one rider to give us a team and two individuals. This later proved to be a wise move.

Entry to the competition site proved interesting, firstly because some anti neighbours removed the directional signs, and secondly because of the deluge of rain and narrow entrance, uphill approach to the site, tractors were necessary to tow boxes and trailers to the lorry park. However, once in situ, the course itself rode very well. The Qualifying competitions apply a maximum of 2015 metres to the course. This taxes the course builder, who has to provide sufficient fences within the distance, without leaving out all the testing ones. Nigel and Juliette Pond did an excellent job in this respect, the loop of the course left out coinciding with the part most water logged. A knock down fence off a corner was an interesting element.

The course is familiar to many of our riders who skipped round it without any difficulties. Julie with Charity had a hesitation at the water but with Julie's persuasion they jumped into the water on the second attempt - very good on the first outing together. Suzanne's steering problems were better than at Offchurch but not yet perfect, and Louise missed out a fence she was certain was

not numbered when she walked the course.

As one of several teams who finished with a zero score, Times nearest to the optimum accumulated for three team members decided the team places. By luck or good judgement we finished in first place. Individual honours went to Rebecca Moore a BVRC member representing Hampshire Rural on this occasion. In second place was Mandy Atkinson-Willes with the veteran Tilley, and Kay Bugden and Lady Guinevere were in fifth place. This was an excellent result and subject to confirmation means that, together with the host club the Chilworth, we go forward to the Championships next May.

Hunter Trial at Larkhill on Sunday 29th October.

I volunteered to incorporate with Area 17 Open Individual & Team Hunter Trial Qualifier for Seniors and Juniors with our own Open HT Class at this year's event. As it happened no juniors came forward, and only 10 seniors entered. The seniors comprised one team and six individuals, five of them came from our own club. This was disappointing. Although we didn't expect too many entries I rather thought it might be a few more than we got.

Entries in all classes were considerably down on numbers for past years. Although this seemed to be a problem before the day, in fact it was a good job that we could finish before the worst of the weather set in. Several, feint hearted, riders didn't turn up on the day. This was their loss because the course rode incredibly well. Larkhill is very unique place, not many courses would have stood up to 48mm of rain overnight and still sustained a good days competition.

As with the Novice Qualifier with maximum course distance is set at 2015 metres - even more difficult to achieve at Larkhill than with most places, as jumps are scattered over quite a large corner of Salisbury Plain. The problem was resolved by moving the XC start and finish to a different place and incorporating one or two interesting turns. Competitors unfamiliar with Larkhill often find it difficult navigating without the aid of a map and a compass. This time familiarity proved an equal impediment. with all the same jumps used, but not necessarily in the same order. One advantage of varying the route meant competitors had a new track to ride on, not a muddy poached one.

Diana, to whom we all look for guidance, proved fallible after all. Having conducted a XC course walk on Saturday (in torrential rain), missed out a fence on both her rides around the Open Course on Sunday (the same fence each time). This was not a very good start for the team, who only had to get three riders round to qualify for the Championships. Luckily Charlotte, being coached by Diana didn't make the same mistake, both she and Susie jumped round clear. Alison did encounter one or two problems but completed the course, so again subject to confirmation the Open team join the Novices at the Championship next May.

Susie's third individual place ensured that she won the Ray Wood cup for the best Open BV member.

The undisclosed optimum time and course distance proved quite a challenge. Not many in the Novice class getting too close. Mads Southey was closest winning the Class and best BV Trophy, unlike her husband Roy who went completely the wrong way (twice)! The Intermediate was a closely fought contest. The winner was 1 second from the optimum and four riders equal on 2 seconds from the optimum. Only 6 seconds from the optimum separated the first 10 competitors. Alan Dale was one of those in equal second place and received the best BV trophy, the first male recipient of a club cup for some considerable time if ever. Alan did participate in Diana's course walk - so some good did come out of it.

Many thanks to all helpers who braved the weather in order that we could hold this event. Particular thanks to the start team, XC stewards and anyone else who was actually stuck out in the weather. Thanks to Jill for her super catering. One fence judge was heard to say she only came for Jill's lunch!
