RIDING CLUBS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS, MALVERN - 12TH SEPTEMBER 1993
Two teams set off at 4.00am in darkness heading for Malvern with Blackthorne,
Black Magic, Piper's Revenge, Scrumpy, Tyson and Fuzzi on board and riders
Gail Perren, Lyn Bruce, Liz White, Carole Perren, last minute replacement, Liz
Derbyshire and Lindsay Kemble, all set to contest the Riding Test and Dressage
Championships.

Everyone had dismissed Gail's anxious enquiry 'What if I'm on at 9am?' But with the full force of Murphys Law, she was drawn to ride at 9.00am and 9.13am, hence our early departure. We hastily shuffled the riding order, so that Lyn was to be the trail blazer and Gail not in two places at once.

Riding Clubs from all over Great Britain converged on Malvern to compete in national finals ranging from team Show Jumping, Equitation Jumping, Veteran Horse/Pony to Team Riding Test, Team Dressage, Individual Medium Dressage, pairs Dressage and 6 member Rural Riders Teams.

Lyn had travelled from Sevenoaks in order to take her team places and Black Magic was suffering from a stomach bug. Liz and Tyson had been given one weeks notice of their substitution making this their fourth ever test.

Conditions were far from conducive to producing good dressage, to get from the lorry park to the dressage arenas entailed passage between two Show Jumping rings and the stable area. Limited warming up areas were further reduced for Liz White who entangled with two 6 string rural rider teams and two blind riders and helpers. A Kit Car exhibition complete with fun fair was clearly audible from the arenas.

The torrential rain held off until our last rider completed her test at 12.15pm. Although we had cursed our early times, we were thankful not to have ridden in the rain.

A lengthy wait ensued, sheltering in the Perrens lorry with numerous cups of tea consumed and results eagerly awaited. Several sorties were undertaken to the scoreboard with little success due to a problem with the scorers which meant no scores appeared until 3.30pm. Our Riding Test scores looked promising but we had an anxious 1 hour wait. The presentation revealed that our team was in fifth place and individual arena awards to Gail (4th) and Carole (5th). By this time dressage scores had materialised revealing that we may also receive awards for this. Our hopes were surpassed by a third place for the team, with Liz White (6th), and Gail (2nd) just missing becoming overall champion by one mark.

These outstanding results are the best ever in the clubs history. To win a rosette at the National Championships is a major achievement, to bring away twelve is exceptional, Gail had nearly a full set with 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th. Congratulations to all concerned.

Many Thanks to Liz White who has the unenviable task of selecting teams, making entries and getting everyone in the right place and the right time, for all team competitions throughout the summer.
