UK Chasers Ride at Kirby Farm, Inkpen on Sunday 9th November, 1997 meet at 10am.

We have arranged a return visit to the UK Chasers Course at Inkpen on the 9th November at 10am. Being UK Chasers, there are lots of jumps of varying heights, none of which you have to jump if you don't want to. It does however, give you a chance to go round a course, set in beautiful countryside, either on your own, or preferably in a group of at least two. If you want to have a go but you don't have anyone to ride with then just give Lindsay Hills a ring on 01264 772388 and she will try to arrange to fit people together. Directions:- From Andover take the A343 towards Newbury. Immediately north of Hurstbourne Tarrant bear left (opposite the garage/petrol station) signed Netherton and Linkenholt. Take the first right to Faccombe. Follow the road through Faccombe and on to the junction at the bottom of the downs. Follow the road round to the right, then straight on past Kirby House to a T junction. Turn left and the entrance to the farm for parking is approximately 100 yards on the left.

Riding Hats Reminder

As of the 1st January 1998, the Riding Clubs are introducing new safety standard for riding hats. Currently the minimum standard allowed is BSI 4472 or 6473 but the recommended standard is the superior PAS015.

BSI 4472 and 6473 are being superseded by a new European Standard hat (BS EN 1384) which offers a higher level of protection. This is in addition to PAS015, which provides the greatest protection.

BSI 4472 and 6473 hats will **NOT** be acceptable at Riding Club events after 1st January 1998.

The recently issued RIDER magazine contained a 10% off voucher for Charles Owen hats, or Ros Linssner is offering 5% discount for hats ordered or bought at the AGM (see below).
