**AGM Report** 

50 members attended this year's AGM held at The Red Lion, Clanville on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November. The Chairman was happy to report that the club had an excellent year. The AGM marked the end of a 2 year integration period with the Woodhay District Riding Club. A transition which has been made very smoothly on all sides. Membership continued to rise, reaching an all time high of 189 members.

The competition programme was improved by the return of the One Day Event and Hunter Trial at Larkhill which added to Winter Dressage and Show Jumping, Spring Dressage, and the popular Combined Training and Summer Show Jumping events. All events were extremely popular, sometimes oversubscribed, helping to make a successful club.

Ten teams, comprising twenty four different club members contested Area 17 inter club events in different disciplines. The Novice Show Jumping teams excelled winning both indoor and outdoor events, and representing Area 17 at the Indoor Championships at Stoneleigh and the outdoor National Riding Clubs Championships at Malvern. The Dressage team joined the Show Jumpers at Malvern. Clare Farrington riding as an individual became the National Medium Dressage Champion. Although we have had team and individual placings nationally in recent years it is about 25 years since we have had an individual winner.

Surveying other competitors at the National Championships it became apparent that they represented a good cross section of Riding Club members – all ages, sizes and shapes and the same was true of the horses.

The Chairman emphasised that the team competitions were open to all members and team places were available for anyone who was keen to take part.

Instruction continued throughout the year – fortnightly Tuesday sessions with Diana Burgess, weekend sessions with Claire Mason and latterly with Sorrel Warwick at Cholderton House Indoor School. Cross Country and Show Jumping schooling were held at Hoplands Equestrian Centre. Two very successful practise Dressage and instructed Clear Round Show jumping evenings were held at Amport Riding Stables.

Social Rides included visits to UK Chasers courses at Firgo Farm, Whitchurch and Kirby Farm, Inkpen, and the annual Hot Cross Bun Ride on Salisbury Plain were enjoyed by all. A club subscription to the RA Hunt enabled members to hunt occasionally at reasonable cost and several people took advantage of this facility.

Stable Management lessons were organised by Sue McGrath and these included excellent talks by vet, Rebecca Hamilton-Fletcher and farrier, Chris Linssner. The annual Quiz and skittles were well supported, but the Barn Dance, although thoroughly enjoyed by those who attended, was poorly supported.

Thanks were passed to the committee members and other helpers who had worked hard all year. Without their efforts it would not be possible to run such a full programme.

Financially the club had a successful year too. A small profit was registered at the end of the year. Profits made from the competitions enabled the club to support huge team costs, and large additions to the club equipment.

Discussion ensued regarding the future of the National Riding Club movement within the British Horse Society. It was agreed that more information was needed before decisions could be made at club level as to whether to stay with the BHS or join a rival faction.

The evening was rounded off with presentation of Be Fair Cup, for the member with most competition points during the year, awarded to Diana Burgess, and the Caballine Trophy, for the member with the most points for helping throughout the year, was awarded to Sue Fentiman. The Caballine Rose Bowl, for the highest placed non committee member in the helpers competition was awarded to Anne Smart. Rosettes to tenth place in each competition were given out. 64 members had helped out during the year and 68 members had points in the competition table (for the full results table see below).

Coffee followed, and Ros Linssner, a qualified hat fitter, from Appleshaw Saddlery, was available to help members choose hats to the new standard which are mandatory from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1998.

### Annual Hunter Trial on 26th October at Larkhill

160 competitors assembled at Larkhill to contest Novice, Intermediate and Open Classes at the Annual Hunter Trial, returning to this super venue after a years absence. Recent refurbishment gave the three separate courses a new feel and with the usual excellent going competitors had an enjoyable ride. Fine, windless, almost warm conditions were untypical for Larkhill which made it very pleasant for the competitors and the large band of helpers. Club members figured strongly in all three classes, only seconds separating the places. Trophies were awarded to the highest placed BVRC members in each class.
